- V. 11 NOW SUPPOSE ONE OF YOU FATHERS IS ASKED BY HIS SON FOR A FISH; HE WILL NOT GIVE HIM A SNAKE INSTEAD OF A FISH, WILL HE?
- V. 12 OR IF HE IS ASKED FOR AN EGG, HE WILL NOT GIVE HIM A SCORPON, WILL HE?
