TENSES OF SALVATION:

* <u>Justification</u>	<u>Sanctification</u>	<u>Glorification</u>
THE <u>Penalty</u> OF SIN IS BROKEN	THE <u>Power</u> OF SIN IS BROKEN	THE <u>Presence</u> OF SIN IS REMOVED

2 CORINTHIANS 5:17 IF ANY MAN BE IN CHRIST HE IS A NEW CREATURE; THE OLD THINGS PASSED AWAY; BEHOLD, NEW THINGS HAVE COME.

REPENTANCE AND CONFESSION OF SIN:

- IS HOW WE begin OUR SPIRITUAL JOURNEY
- IS ALSO A Constant WAY OF LIFE FOR THE ONE WHO COMES TO CHRIST

THE CONTRAST:

LIGHT: REPRESENTS GOD AND eternal LIFE

- TRUE CHRISTIANS walk IN THE LIGHT

DARKNESS: REPRESENTS Sin AND DEATH

- NON CHRISTIANS walk IN DEEDS OF DARKNESS

THE WORD "WALK" MEANS:

- AS A habit OF LIFE

JOHN 13: 6-10 SO HE CAME TO SIMON PETER. HE SAID TO HIM, "LORD, DO YOU WASH MY FEET?" JESUS ANSWERED HIM AND SAID TO HIM, "WHAT I DO YOU DO NOT REALIZE NOW, BUT YOU WILL UNDERSTAND HEREAFTER." PETER SAID TO JESUS, "NEVER SHALL YOU WASH MY FEET!" JESUS ANSWERED HIM, "IF I DO NOT WASH YOUR, YOU HAVE NO PART WITH ME." SIMON PETER SAID TO HIM, "LORD, THEN WASH NOT ONLY MY FEET BUT ALSO MY HANDS AND MY HEAD." JESUS SAID TO HIM, "HE WHO HAS BATHED NEEDS ONLY TO WASH HIS FEET, BUT IS COMPLETELY CLEAN; AND YOU ARE CLEAN."

2 KINDS OF FORGIVENESS:

1. THE Judicial FORGIVENESS OF GOD ILLUSTRATES THE DOCTRINE OF Justification
2. THE Paternal FORGIVENESS OF GOD LOOKS AT GOD NOT AS A JUDGE BUT AS A Father ILLUSTRATES THE DOCTRINE OF Sanctification

- CONFESSION OF SIN DOES NOT NULLIFY ALL THE Consequences OF OUR SIN
- UNCONFESSED SIN IN THE LIFE OF A CHILD OF GOD LEADS TO God's discipline
