AND THEIR EXPANSE IS DECLARING THE WORK OF HIS HANDS.

V. 2 DAY TO DAY POURS FORTH SPEECH,
AND NIGHT TO NIGHT REVEALS KNOWLEDGE.

V. 3 THERE IS NO SPEECH, NOR ARE THERE WORDS;
THEIR VOICE IS NOT HEARD.

V. 4 THEIR LINE HAS GONE OUT THROUGH ALL THE EARTH, AND THEIR UTTERANCES TO
THE END OF THE WORLD.

IN THEM HE HAS PLACED A TENT FOR THE SUN,

V. 5 WHICH IS AS A BRIDEGROOM COMING OUT OF HIS CHAMBER;
IT REJOICES AS A STRONG MAN TO RUN HIS COURSE.

V. 6 ITS RISING IS FROM ONE END OF THE HEAVENS, AND ITS CIRCUIT TO THE OTHER
END OF THEM;

AND THERE IS NOTHING HIDDEN FROM ITS HEAT.

**V. 9 THE FEAR OF THE LORD IS CLEAN, ENDURING FOREVER;
THE JUDGEMENTS OF THE LORD ARE TRUE; THEY ARE RIGHTEOUS
ALTOGETHER.**

V. 10 THEY ARE MORE DESIRABLE THAN GOLD, YES, THAN MUCH FINE GOLD; SWEETER
ALSO THAN HONEY AND THE DRIPPINGS OF THE HONEYCOMB.

V. 11 MOREOVER, BY THEM YOUR SERVANT IS WARNED;
IN KEEPING THEM THERE IS GREAT REWARD.

V. 12 WHO CAN DISCERN HIS ERRORS?
ACQUIT ME OF HIDDEN FAULTS.

V. 13 ALSO KEEP BACK YOUR SERVANT FROM PRESUMPTUOUS SINS;
LET THEM NOT RULE OVER ME;
THEN I WILL BE BLAMELESS, AND I SHALL BE ACQUITTED OF GREAT TRANSGRESSION.

V. 14 LET THE WORDS OF MY MOUTH AND THE MEDITATION OF MY HEART BE
ACCEPTABLE IN YOUR SIGHT, O LORD, MY ROCK AND MY REDEEMER.
